

## Swarm Collectors.

If you cannot contact the one nearest to you, then go to the next nearest on the list below. Be patient, because during the swarming season all of us may be very busy collecting swarms! We usually make a charge to cover our petrol expenses and time.

Normally we charge £20 callout as this could involve returning in the evening to collect the flying, but this is open to discussion with the collector.

The bees you see flying around are the scout bees that have been negotiating a new home, which could be in a chimney, under roof tiles or outbuildings. If they take up residence in your home this would involve scaffolding and a great deal of time and cost to get them removed!!
