INTRODUCTION TO BEEKEEPING BOOKING FORM

Date and Time: Saturday 16th October or Sunday 24th October 10am to 4pm

This course will be a very basic introduction to beekeeping aimed at those with no previous experience. The purpose is to introduce interested beginners to the responsibilities of beekeeping, the basic lifecycle and behaviour of honey bees, and the logistics and commitment needed to keep honey bees in a domestic environment, This is a classroom event. Visits to the branch apiary for hands-on experience will be arranged separately.
